

# STATEWIDE INITIATIVE TO SPOT AND REPORT HUMAN TRAFFICKING TRAINING CHECKLIST

## STEP ONE: AWARENESS TRAINING

- Show the *TABC Stop Human Trafficking video*<sup>1</sup> to staff.
  - Consider submitting a [request](#)<sup>2</sup> to invite TABC to conduct an in-person (or virtual) training.
  - Consider inviting elected officials to your warehouse or record remarks to show before screening the video.
  - Consider making the training video part of your company's onboarding process.
- Provide staff with tip cards listing human trafficking red flags.
- Download and hang a breakroom poster on how to spot the signs of human trafficking.
- Fill out the training completion form on the WBDT [website](#)<sup>3</sup> to get your company's certificate.

## STEP TWO: COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Use the social media toolkit to share your involvement.
- Order decals and truck signs with the statewide human trafficking hotline for your delivery vehicles to spread awareness on your routes.
- Use the letter templates to notify elected officials about your involvement.
  - Examples: governor, state attorney general, members of Congress, state legislators
- Partner with local or state non-profit organizations that are working to end human trafficking.
