STEP ONE: AWARENESS TRAINING

- □ Show the TABC Stop Human Trafficking <u>video</u>¹ to staff.
 - Consider submitting a <u>request²</u> to invite TABC to conduct an in-person (or virtual) training.
 - Consider inviting elected officials to your warehouse or record remarks to show before screening the video.
 - · Consider making the training video part of your company's onboarding process.
- D Provide staff with tip cards listing human trafficking red flags.
- Download and hang a breakroom poster on how to spot the signs of human trafficking.
- □ Fill out the training completion form on the WBDT <u>website³</u> to get your company's certificate.
